What Students Will Do:

- **Trope** (5th/6th) – Learn to sing trope – Torah (5th grade) or Haftarah
- **Torah Service** (6th) – Learn the prayers and their purpose/meaning
- **Inauguration** (6th) – Participate in B'nai Mitzvah Inauguration (May 14th)
- **TnT prayers** (6th) – Lead Torah Service prayers in TnT
- **TnT readings** – Chant 2 Torah (5th); 2 Torah + 2 Haftarah (6th)

To do a reading at TnT, you must pass it in class the Sunday prior. If you don't, you get another reading for a later TnT. Readings are assigned 1-2 months in advance.

What Parents Can Do:

- **Practice** – Encourage practice between classes each week, and doing homework. Encourage steady, regular practice – not cramming.
- **Punctuality** – Have your child here on time, ready to start at 9.
- **Ask!** – Ask Doug anything about what your child is doing. The more you know, the more you can help or inspire them. No question is too basic
- **Services** – Bring your child to services. We learn by doing.
- **Party?** – Encourage that the bar/bat mitzvah is about more than the party.
- **Relevance** – Encourage that learning trope and tefilah is more than just “that stuff you need to know for your bar/bat mitzvah.”
